### September 3, 2015 PTO Meeting Minutes

**President's Report:** Staci Rusch called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone in attendance. She also asked any committee chairs that still needed their binder to please come up to the front table to retrieve it.

**Treasurer's Report:** Reviewed budget from previous year and confirmed that we came in under budget last year.

Highlights from this year's budget thus far: Some expenses have come in from last year that will hit this year's budget. Some membership dues have already been received. A deposit from last year's plant sale came into this year's budget. An expense went out this year for Yankee candle. Taxes have already been prepared and a check will be going out for Illinois charities. We have also paid insurance for the year, for our directory and the back to school bash against this year's operating budget.

**Principal's Report:** One of the changes made that is working out great is the pick-up procedure. It has been a good improvement to ensure safety for our children this year. We also have a new food service company this year and it has been a huge success with the children and the staff. We are in year 2 of a positive behavior support system – there are 8 areas within the school and behavior expectations for each of the 8 areas. The school improvement team is also addressing after school release to eliminate some areas that need improvement.

Kelly Cook introduced herself and explained her role as the learning coach. Bill Harrison (President of the school board) and Pamela Becker Dean (Vice President of school board) were in attendance and introduced themselves.

### **Vice President's Report:**

Art Awareness: 3 artists chosen, books chosen and forms sent out. Also took over square 1 art. Waiting for volunteer forms to come in to get the first one scheduled.

Back to School Bash: Success! Thank you to Vicki Herda for her awesome magnet sales and to all who attended and volunteered at the event!

Birthday Book Club: Chair not present – Karen explained the club

Coupon Books: Chair not present

Directory: Chair not present – informed the group that we will again have a paper directory as well as an online directory. Notice sent home with the 5<sup>th</sup> graders for the artwork for this year's version.

Membership: Kelly Cook asked us to send a reminder to the staff to submit their membership dues. The staff is shooting for 100% membership!

Newcomer/Kindergarten Welcome: Success!

Savings Card: Chair not present – A flyer will be going out soon to purchase your card for \$10.

School Supply Kit: Looking into potentially adding \$1-2 to the price of the kits to make PTO some money next year. This past year, PTO did not add any profit to the costs.
