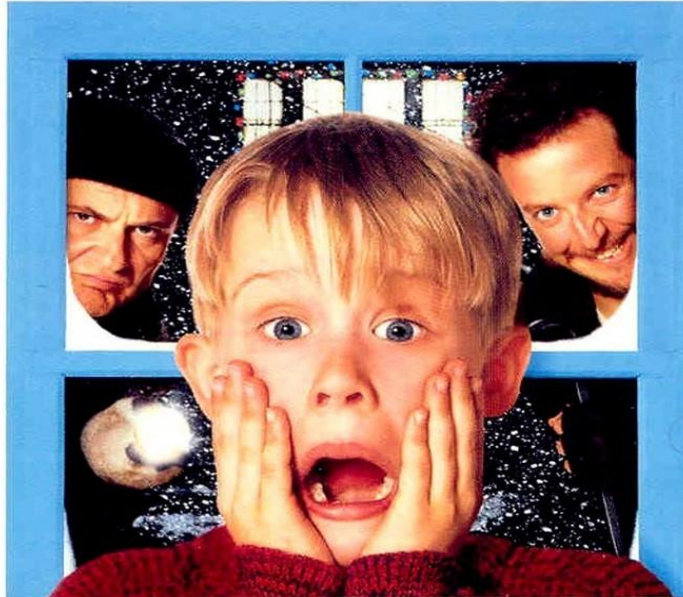

Movie Night Guidelines and Rules

Please Read and Discuss with Your Children

1. ALL ATTENDEES MUST BE CURRENT STUDENTS AT LONGFELLOW SCHOOL.

No younger or older siblings allowed. Parents are welcome to stay if they volunteer to help.

2. PICK-UP and DROP-OFF RULES:

- **Children must be signed in and out at the Front Door by an Adult.**
- **Therefore, will be NO DROP-OFFS for their own safety.**
- **When you sign in, please provide an Emergency Phone number (MANDATORY). We must be able to contact you during the movie, in case your child becomes ill.**
- **Again, please remember to sign out ALL your assigned children!**

3. FOOD: DINNER, CONCESSIONS, and OUTSIDE FOOD

- **Dinner must be pre-ordered; we will not have extra dinners. No refunds on food orders.**
- **We highly recommend that you pre-order concession tickets**
- **Dinner will be served in the Multi-Purpose Hallway; concessions will be in the Gym.**
- **We also ask that NO outside food is brought into Longfellow. If this is a necessity due to allergies, please send an email to bglongfellowpto@gmail.com**

4. ELECTRONICS:

PLEASE LEAVE ALL CELL PHONES, IPADS, ETC. AT HOME. They are not allowed to be on during the movie. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

5. WHAT TO BRING:

Children may wear pajamas and/or bring their sleeping bags/pillows. All items should be labeled. Shoes should be worn at all times to prevent children from slipping on the school's slick floor. Also, please take your child's coat to your car to reduce bulk in the room and to save their coats from spills.

6. BATHROOM BREAKS

Children may only use the bathroom during the assigned break (45 minutes after the movie has started), unless injured or sick. They may not leave during the movie.

7. MEDICAL NOTICE:

There is no nurse on site, we cannot store or administer any medications.

8. EXPECTED BEHAVIOR:

Any student who does not follow the guidelines and rules will have their parents called and will not be permitted to attend future Movie Night events.

Guidelines include:

- **no talking during movie**
- **no throwing food/drink**
- **no running**
- **no injuring other students**
